

2017 FRANK SEDGMAN CUP MIXED TEAMS EVENT

TEAM ENTRY FORM

CONDITIONS AND NOTES: Entries close 7 JULY 2017 TO BAYSIDE MORRABBIN

1. The event will be a pool round robin tournament that is open to all Tennis Victoria Country Regions and Metropolitan Associations who may enter a team of 2 boys and 2 girls who are to be 11 years of age or under as at 31 July, 2017.
2. All players nominated must be a member of a club affiliated with Tennis Victoria and play competitively and/or train with the Region/Association.
3. The tournament will be conducted on the hard courts at the Bendigo Tennis Association, Nolan St, Bendigo, 3552
4. This event shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the game adopted by Tennis Australia and the Tournament Conditions laid down by Tennis Victoria. The Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour will apply.
5. Each round will consist of 4 singles matches and 2 mixed doubles matches with each player participating in one singles match and one mixed doubles match per round. All matches will be one 6 game set with a tiebreaker to be played at 6 games all. All mixed doubles matches will be sudden death deuce.
6. Teams must be entered on the Entry Form with players listed in singles ranking order. Any team changes to the nominated singles order of players must be received in writing by Tennis Victoria prior to the event, but no later than the conclusion of the Team Managers' meeting on the 1st day.
7. The tournament will commence at 9.00am Saturday 29 July 2017.
8. The Tournament Manager and Referee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament upon commencement.

10. **TENNIS VICTORIA PLAYER REGISTRATION**
All entrants are to be current registered participants of Tennis Victoria
11. All players and parents/guardians are to complete and sign the **PLAYER DECLARATION FORM** which the Region or Association will send to Tennis Victoria with the Team Entry Form.
12. Any dispute in regard to the Frank Sedgman Cup should be directed to the Tournament Manager and/or Referee.
13. The tournament will be governed by:
 - a) The ITF Rules of Tennis,
 - b) The ITF Duties & Procedures for Officials,
 - c) Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour,
 - d) Tennis Australia Dress & Equipment Regulations, noting that teams are encouraged to wear team clothing, which provided they reasonably comply with the Dress regulations will be approved for play.
14. **EMERGENCY/SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS**
Where emergency or substitute player(s) are needed to be used, those player(s) should be used for that entire tie/round and must meet the player eligibility conditions.
